Job Description

Stone Co. Climbing is looking for a self-motivated, detail-oriented, and all around rockstar to become our next **Head of Routesetting & Programs (or Part-time Head Routetter)**. This individual is critical to making the machine run, and will be ensuring things are "well-oiled" all around. This is a critical role at the very heart of the company. As a leader at Stone Co., you will truly have the ability to impact thousands in *Building Strong Community Through Climbing*. This is mostly a behind-the-scenes role, and the right person will love learning, growing a team, being creative, getting hands-on, and running a "system" through which others will thrive.

The **Head of Routesetting & Programs** oversees a team of 5-7 routesetters and 5-7 instructors, and reports to the CEO. You will be wearing many hats, so prioritizing and coordinating should come naturally to you and be a skill that energizes you to put into practice. You will be doing more management and tracking than anything else, but routesetting and instructing will be important individual skillsets to perform as well. The following functions are under the management of the Head of Routesetting & Programs:





- **Management:** track weekly status with CEO and participate in highest level of company strategy; coordinate needs with other Managers; recruiting/interviewing, scheduling, training, correcting, motivating, and coordinating updates and promotions with staff; serve as authority figure and point-of-contact when in the gym even across other departments if other Managers are not present; TEAM UNITY and growth is very important at Stone Co.
- **Budgeting / Inventory / Equipment:** buying supplies, equipment, holds/volumes, monitoring inventory levels and organization
- Setting: oversee stripping and cleaning of holds and walls, organization, and setting each week. Set and forerun along with the team, ensuring a balance of creative, technical, and aesthetic climbs; be the admin for Kaya/Plastick
- **Instructing:** develop fun and innovative programs including but not limited to competitions, camps, birthday parties, group events, competitive climbing team, classes, and after-school programs; step in as an instructor when/where needed
- **Documentation:** maintains company policies, processes, and procedures related to your areas of responsibility

Qualifications:

- At least 1 year of commercial route-setting experience, preferably in a management role
- Ability to forerun V7+
- Methodical, structured
- Self-starter, prefers making sure things are properly tracked and documented
- Strong oral and written communication skills

- USAC Level 1 Certification or higher
- Management experience
- Bachelor's degree
